Route 59 tram service changes from **Saturday 7 January to Friday 13 January 2012** during tram improvement works on Mt Alexander Road.

Route 59 trams will be replaced by buses between **Stop 20** Melrose Street & Flemington Road and **Stop 27** Essendon Tram Depot.

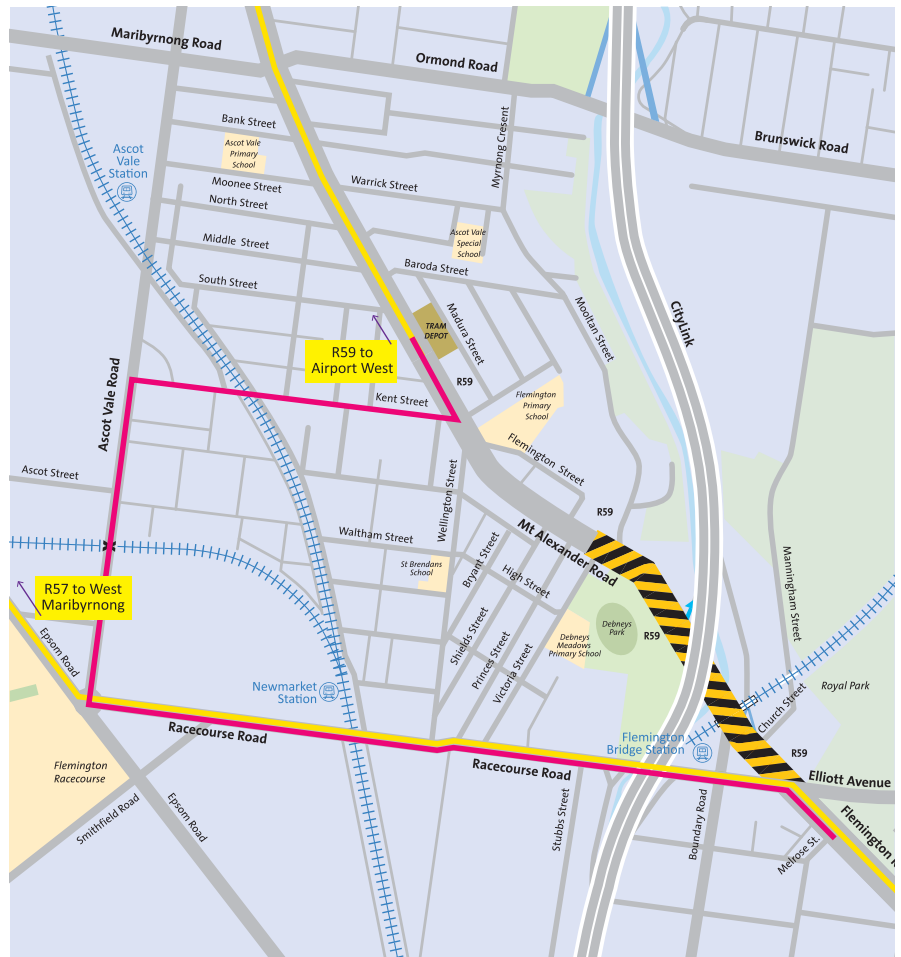
The tram replacement bus will divert around the works in both directions via Flemington Road, Racecourse Road, Ascot Vale Road, Kent Street and Mt Alexander Road.

Tram **stops 22** (Boundary Road & Flemington Road) to **26** (Wellington Street & Mt Alexander Road) will not be serviced by trams or the tram replacement bus service.

Route 57 trams will operate as normal.

Routes 55 and 59 will run to a reduced frequency.

The **Route 59** transport improvement project will improve tram travel times on Mt Alexander Road, Travancore.

Trams will have their own tramway to avoid traffic congestion in the area. The road will be widened to maintain the same number of lanes for motorists.

A new accessible tram stop will be constructed at **Stop 23** Flemington Community Centre. Accessible stops make using Melbourne's trams easier for people with a mobility impairment and also enhance safety by separating tram passengers from passing traffic.
